# Did you know that around 8% of the European Union's population, which equals approximately 34 million inhabitants, were born outside of the EU?

Unfortunately, many non-EU born adults seeking connection to the labor market, lack a high level of education, and young migrants are more likely to drop out of school and be at risk of poverty or social exclusion.

The BuddyMigrants project aims to support schools as integration hubs for an inclusive society. It has two main objectives:

Addressing barriers for newly-arrived third country national families accessing social services and promoting inclusive environments. The project prioritizes raising awareness of EU values, encouraging participation in democratic life, and developing social and intercultural competences.

It achieves this through a pedagogical toolkit, teacher curriculum, local family groups for social inclusion, and a network for peer learning.
