Development of the project's Online Educational Platform

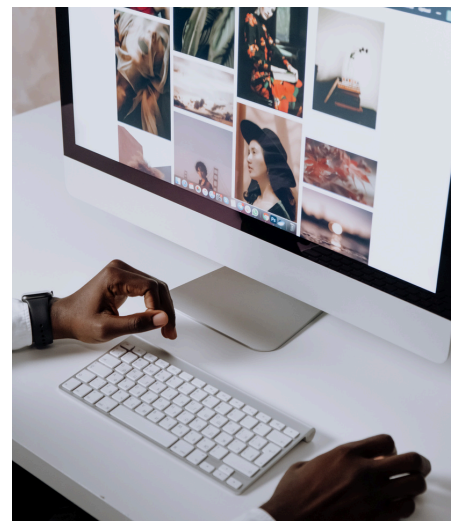
Where we're at right now?!

We are developing our **Online Educational Platform** for the Buddy Migrants project, led by **The Square Dot Team**, partner organization from Leuven, Belgium.

This Platform will give access to a tailor-made pedagogical toolkit and curriculum for intercultural and global citizenship education dedicated mainly to teachers from all 5 project countries.

The Educational Platform will features a **new curriculum for teachers with statistic formation on migration and intercultural education** that can be implemented afterwards with their students. The Platform will include as well a space for the results from activities of the curriculum implemented by the teachers, with videos, photos, activity reports, and feedback and it counts with a section for Local Network Actions too as well as a contributory and interactive section.

The Online Educational Platform is intended to start operating by the end of May 2024.





What is Buddy Migrants about?

With this Project, we strive to support schools in their potential as hubs for integration and therefore the development of an inclusive society. The Buddy Migrants Project has two main objectives. Firstly, it aims to address the barriers that newly-arrived third country national families face when accessing social services such as education, healthcare, employment, and information. Secondly, it aims to promote inclusive environments that foster social inclusion, equity, and equality, and respond to the needs of the wider communities in the project countries.

The Project's priorities are to raise awareness of European Union common values and principles among newly-arrived TCN families, encourage their participation in democratic life, and help them overcome difficulties in actively engaging and participating in their communities. Additionally, Buddy Migrants aims to develop the social and intercultural competences and critical thinking of teachers, parents, and children, and offer opportunities for participation in social and civic engagement through formal and non-formal learning activities.
